STÉPHANIE
Bonjour, Amélie

AMÉLIE
Salut, Stephanie, Comment ça va?

STÉPHANIE
Ça va bien, et toi?

AMÉLIE
Je suis fatigué

The characters pause. Narrator speaks.

NARRATOR
Stéphanie and Amélie are meeting each other at a café. Stéphanie asked Amélie how she was doing. Amélie said, "Je suis fatigué." What did Amélie say to Stéphanie how she was feeling?

List of responses appear on screen. Close up of tired Amélie.

NARRATOR (CONT'D)
Did Amélie say she was happy? Did Amélie say she was excited? Did Amélie say she was tired? Or did Amélie say she was sad?

Pause

NARRATOR (CONT'D)
Amélie said she was fatigué, or tired.

STÉPHANIE
Tu est fatigué? Pourquoi?

AMÉLIE
Mon sœur est restée debout devant la télé

NARRATOR
We haven't gone over families, yet, but mon soeur means "my sister." Amélie's sister stayed up watching TV last night, keeping her awake.

STÉPHANIE
Ah, désolé. ça va aller.

AMÉLIE

Oui. Comment allez-vous?

STÉPHANIE

Ah, je suis content.

PAUSE

NARRATOR

Amélie told Stéphanie she was fatigué, or tired. Stéphanie told Amélie she was "content." What do you think content means?

Show Happy Stéphanie.

NARRATOR (CONT'D)

Do you think Stéphanie is sad? Do you think Stéphanie is tired? Do you think Stéphanie is happy?

PAUSE

NARRATOR (CONT'D)

If you said you think Stéphanie was content, or HAPPY, then you were right!

STÉPHANIE

Je suis content.

AMÉLIE

Tu est content? Pourquoi?

STÉPHANIE

Je passe du temps avec mon amie.
